Subject: Regarding generation of Unique Student Id (USID) for students enrolled under National Agricultural Research and Education System(NARES).

Dear Sir/Madam,

In accordance to the Digital India Programme of Government of India (GoI), Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) is taking major e-governance initiative across various sectors. EKTA (Eakikrit Krishishiksha Takniki Ayaam) is one such initiative taken by Education Division, ICAR. Under EKTA initiative, it is decided that a Unique Student ID (USID) will be given to all the students enrolled under National Agricultural Research and Education System (NARES). The USID, a 15 digit alphanumeric code will be allotted to each student at his/her first entry in the NARES by the University/College. It will remain same even if the student migrates from one university to other for higher studies. Further, it will be a identity number which will even useful to students in their employment in future. Complete details about the USID and its generation is available at the Education portal, ICAR (<a href="http://education.icar.gov.in">http://education.icar.gov.in</a>). You are requested to allot USID number to each student admitting in 2017-18 in your accredited program and college.
