Objective of ASEAN-India Fellowship

- To help students from ASEAN Member States in getting quality research-based education, thus bringing India and ASEAN community closer to one another.
- To provide platform for cross-cultural and transnational sharing of knowledge amongst the students coming from ASEAN countries

ASEAN-India Fellowship

- To pursue Masters Degree in Agriculture and Allied Sciences, in the identified priority areas as per need, in the best Indian Agricultural Universities under the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR) and Agriculture Universities (AU) systems, having strong research and teaching capabilities.
- Total 50 fellowships (10 per year) to be awarded to students of ASEAN member states for PG programme in Agriculture and Allied Sciences starting from the Academic Year 2024-25.
- Funding under the ASEAN-India Fund for five years which includes the student's fellowship, admission fees, living expenses and contingency.

ASEAN-India Fellowship For the Year 2024-25

The Government of India and the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) have initiated a fellowship program ASEAN-India Fellowship for Higher Education in Agriculture and Allied Sciences to strengthen the educational and cultural ties between India and the ASEAN member countries. This fellowship aims to promote academic exchange and cooperation between India and the ASEAN and shall help in the creation of a pool of expert human resources in ASEAN member countries on Agriculture and Allied Sciences which shall ultimately help in the upliftment of the socio-economic status and livelihood of the general population of ASEAN nations.

Under this new initiative, the students from ASEAN member countries shall be admitted to Indian Agricultural Universities from the academic session 2024-25 to pursue their Masters degree program in different disciplines of Agriculture and Allied Sciences. The fellowship includes Institute Economic/Bench fees, accommodation and a stipend ensuring that the selected candidates can fully immerse themselves in the academic and cultural environment of the Indian universities.
