

## Skills in Agriculture Education and Entrepreneurship Development (SEED)

### (Agriculture Education, Entrepreneurship and Skill Development)

The Agriculture education system is reorienting itself towards entrepreneurship and skill development to meet global challenges. It demands understanding of different approaches, methods and developing strategies by the teachers, scientists and extension professionals' serving in different institutes for the development of farming community. In order to facilitate the discussions and orient scientists, teachers and extension professional, a winter school on Skills in Agriculture Education and Entrepreneurship Development (SEED) is being organised at College of Agriculture, University of Agricultural Sciences (UAS), Dharwad (Karnataka) from **6<sup>th</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> November 2019**. It aims to facilitate focused discussions on the area of agriculture education, entrepreneurship and skill development leading to quality human resource development.

### Content

The Winter School includes sessions on Agriculture education,- current status and future challenges, effective methods in agriculture education and global challenges. The major focus is on entrepreneurship development with topics like product identification, incubation and management with an emphasis on business opportunities in agriculture and skill development methods and approaches. The content includes study of successful enterprises / entrepreneurs, supporting institutions, government policy / programmes of entrepreneurship / skill development. To meet the

needs of diverse participants, business opportunities in different sectors of agriculture are scheduled in the winter school.

The winter school is planned to conduct in participative mode with more field experiences by analysis of cases, practical exercises, field visits and group discussions.

### Venue

The Winter School will be held at Department of Agricultural Extension Education, College of Agriculture, Dharwad, UAS(D). The twin cities of Dharwad and Hubballi are well connected by air, rail and road. The nearest airports are Hubballi (27 km), Belgaum (73 km), Goa(160 km) and Pune (417km). It is on the National Highway No.4 connecting Mumbai (Maharashtra) and Bengaluru(Karnataka). The mean monthly maximum and minimum temperatures are around 29° C and 16° C during November month.

### Dharwad City

Dharwad is known as an education hub in North Karnataka due to the fact that it has four universities IIT and IIIT. It is well known for classical singers of International repute and also Jnayanapith awardees. Hubballi-Dharwad is the second-largest city in Karnataka after Bengaluru. While Dharwad is the administrative headquarters, the city of Hubballi, is the commercial centre and business hub of North Karnataka. Dharwad is famous for its Dharwad Pedā – a milk based sweet and Kasuti Cotton Sarees.

The twin cities are familiar for their historical monuments of architectural & religious importance, Dharwad district is surrounded by places of natural beauty such as Dandeli reserve forest and Goa

beaches. The glorious historic monument of Vijayapur is located at a distance of 150 kms.

Situated on the edge of the western ghats, places around Dharwad have much to offer to the tourist.

### Eligibility

The Winter School is open for Teachers / Scientists / Extension workers of all disciplines of SAUs and ICAR institutes in the rank of Assistant Professor and above. About 25-30 participants will be selected.

### Travel and accommodation

Selected participants will be provided to & fro train fare limiting to II- AC/bus by shortest route on production of receipt/ticket. Free lodging and boarding will be provided for the participants in Scientists Home. The participants should abide by the rules and regulations of the guest house.
